OFFICIAL RULES

1. This is an open amateur tournament: **NO PROFESSIONALS OR GUIDES allowed.** The entry fee is \$100 per boat, which includes two anglers and two Weigh-In Party meal tickets. Tournament merchandise (T-shirts, cups, raffle tickets, etc.) will be sold separately on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Tournament hours will be 6:30am (shotgun start from Beemis Bay) until close of Weigh-In. Weigh-In will start at 2:00 pm and end at 3:30 pm. At least one participant from the team must be in line with fish in hand at St. Paul's Chapel by 3:30 pm or the team will be disqualified. In the event of a tie, the earlier weigh-in shall win. **NO FISHING ALLOWED UNTIL 6:30 am Saturday, October 22nd.**
3. All fishing will be done in the Magnolia River, Weeks Bay, Fish River, or Mobile Bay. Both live and artificial bait may be used.
4. All fish must be caught with rod and reel in accordance with the current Alabama fishing rules and regulations. **FISH MUST BE CAUGHT ON THE DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT.** Speckled Trout **MUST** be 14" minimum. Redfish **MUST** be in the slot limit for Alabama, which is 16" minimum, 26" maximum total length, measured with a pinched tail on tournament weigh stick.
5. The Weigh Master's decision is final. **NO CHEATING WILL BE TOLERATED.**
6. Only **ONE FISH** per person is allowed to win in category. In the event of a tie, the earlier weigh-in shall win.
7. Competition for the Bishop's Cup is limited to members of Episcopal churches and requires an additional donation. The Bishop's Cup will be awarded for the largest speckled trout caught by an entrant in the Bishop's Cup competition.
8. Junior Division (under age 12) prizes shall be separate.
9. For safety and legal reasons all entrants shall follow Alabama State Laws regarding the use of alcohol while participating in this tournament.
10. Any violation of these rules will result in disqualification of the entire team. Decisions on disqualifications will be made by the tournament committee officials and will be final.
11. Each contestant, evidenced by his/her entry in the tournament, does hereby release and agree to protect, indemnify and hold harmless, the tournament committee from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action of any sort and damages resulting from an accident, incident or occurrence arising from, incidental to, or in any way resulting from his/her participation in this tournament. Each contestant hereby further covenants and agrees for him/herself, his/her heirs, successors and assigners, that they will not make and claim or institute any suit or action at law or equity against the committee, its agents, representatives, successors or assigns, arising out of injury or damage a contestant may suffer while participating in this tournament.
12. The lunker pot will be split 70:30 with St. Paul's Episcopal Chapel—the winner will receive 70 percent and St. Paul's will receive 30 percent.
13. This is a charitable event, and we appreciate all entries. Remember, the Tournament Committee officials have the final say on any conflict or problem. This is not negotiable.
